Mayor and Council: This is an update on some of the City's priority needs by category:

Infrastructure:

- 1. Ash Street, Maple. Street, and Seventh Street (between East Dykes Street @ Dinah Street) were resurfaced with T-SPLOST funds by Dykes Grassing Company. This project had been planned for some time. I'll identify other road funding opportunities.
- 2. Approximately \$480,000 in bond revenue is on-hand to fund the system mapping project and maintain the four tanks, line repair and improvements, lift station work.
- 3. The required gas system leak survey is now being conducted by Jointly-Owned gas contracting company.
- 4. The federal CDBG-funded sewer improvement project has begun design.
- 5. We have begun the process of assessing the buildings the City owns.

Personnel:

- 1. Department heads have expressed personnel needs. Until we have a valid final statement, we will not commit to new positions.
- 2. Job evaluations we'll be developing and training for our first-ever job evaluations in February.
- 3. Safety- we're conducting a Worker's Compensation 101 class for department heads to be held on Thursday, January 15th.

Administrative:

- 1. Department heads will be reviewing new personnel policy with employees.
- 2. We're enforcing the sewer ordinance regarding restaurant grease traps.
- 3. We'll begin the internal budget preparation later in January. Council budget sessions will begin in March.
